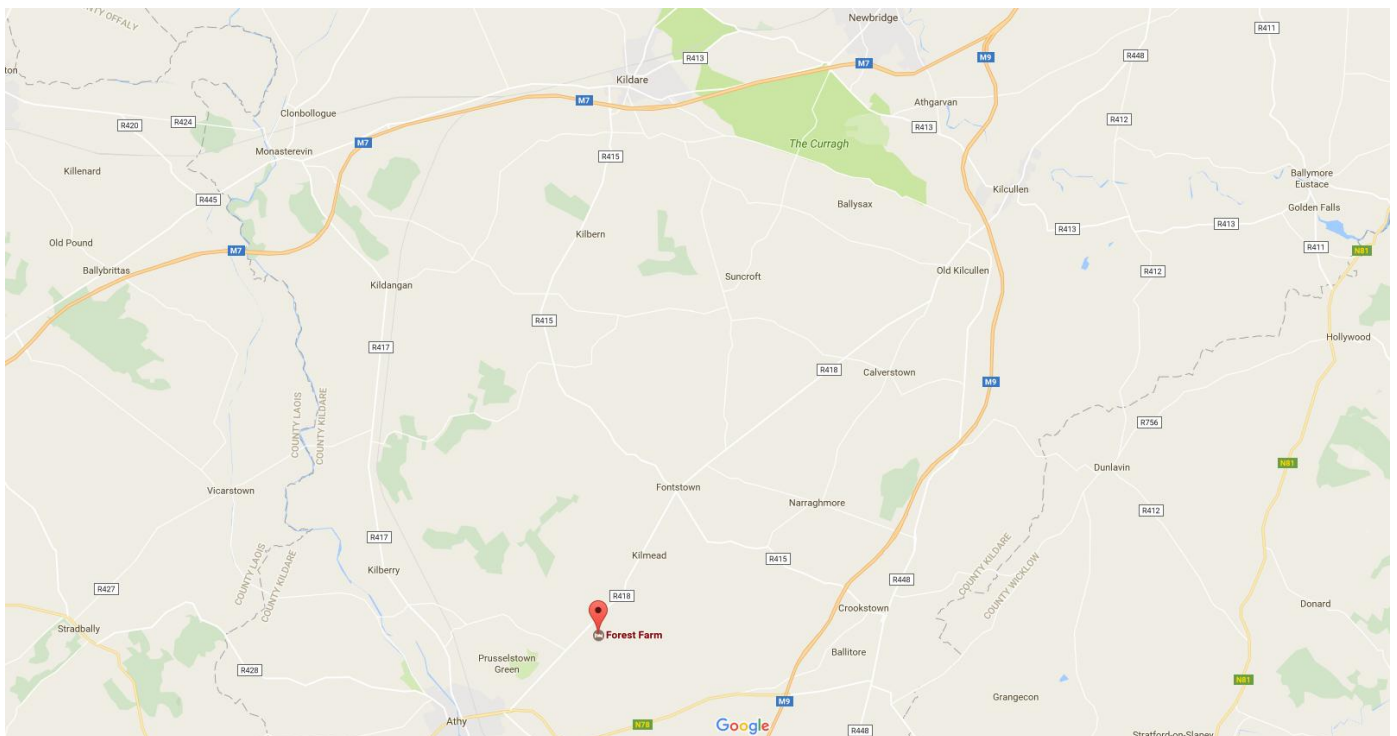

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

AGILITY GRADING SYSTEM

Grade 1	For handlers or dogs that have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at IADSA licensed Agility Shows. <i>N.B. Owners or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.</i>
Grade 2	For handlers or dogs which have qualified out of Grade 1 but have not gained a first place in an Agility Class or three first places in Jumping Classes at Grade 2 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows, or elected to progress on points from Grade 1. <i>N.B. owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 2 are not eligible for this class.</i>
Grade 3	Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or 2 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 4, 5, 6 or 7. Experienced handlers start their new dogs here.
Grade 4	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class at Grade 3 or elected to progress on points from Grade 3 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 5, 6 or 7
Grade 5	Open to dogs which have gained a first place in an Agility Class at Grade 4 or elected to progress on points from Grade 4 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 6 or 7
Grade 6	Open to dogs which have gained three first places in a class at Grade 5 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows and dogs which are not eligible for Grade 3, 4, 5, or 7. One first place must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.
Grade 7	Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 6 at IADSA licensed Agility Shows. Two first places must be gained in Agility (not Jumping) Classes.

***** All dogs must be registered with the IADSA *****

Owners/Handlers must bring to the show their agility record books containing the officially recorded height of their dogs.

Dogs from IKC, Northern Ireland, the UK or any other organisation

Dogs that compete under IKC, KC or other organisation regulations will join IADSA at the grade equivalent to the grade they work in their own country/organisation up to G5. There after dogs will progress separately.

***** No dog can transfer into a higher grade than grade 5 when becoming a new member *****

Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damaged caused.



PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE...

- No practice will be allowed on agility equipment in the competition ring prior to competition.
- Failure to comply with the rules and regulations of the show will lead to automatic disqualification.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Dogs under 18 months of age are not eligible to enter.
- All wins prior to the day specified for the closing of entries shall be taken into account when entering any class.
- It is the competitors' responsibility to be available for their class.
- Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds, and mating of bitches within the precinct of the show grounds is strictly forbidden.
- Dogs must be kept under proper control at all times.
- Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A flat, close fitting, leather or webbing collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
- Handlers will be permitted to walk the courses before judging commences.
- All competitors must show respect for the judge.
- IADSA will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accidents by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
- Exhibitors must **clean up** if their dogs foul the grounds. Suitable facilities will be provided for this.
- The Committee reserves the right to appoint a substitute Judge if circumstances prevent an appointed Judge from fulfilling the appointment.
- Height of Jumps – as per IADSA Rules & Regulations.
- Training rounds are at the judge's discretion
- All dogs must be kept on lead at all times around the ring and in the camping area; the show secretary has the right to ask handlers to leave if they don't comply
- Food is not to be carried into the ring by hand or on the handler's person anywhere. All food must be left outside the ring.

*****BE AWARE OF YOUR DOG(S) AT ALL TIMES*****

It goes without saying that **ALL DOGS ARE TO BE KEPT ON LEAD** during a show and please note that there is **NO EXCEPTION** to this rule. The show secretary has the right to ask anyone not complying with this rule to leave the venue immediately.

ALSO... even when your dog is on lead you **MUST** maintain **AWARENESS** of them at **ALL TIMES!!** For the safety of your dog and everyone surrounding you.

This is a very excitable and stressful environment that we are asking our dogs to endure so you must make sure to respect your dog in this situation. Regardless of how you think your dog will act or behave, this can change very quickly depending on circumstances, so please **WATCH** them. If everyone does this then it reduces the risk of any dangerous interactions happening at our shows.

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO WATCH YOUR DOG(S) SO PLEASE DO SO!!

Please note: *This is a very serious warning put in place for the safety of both dogs and people at our shows so we ask that you adhere to it very carefully. We will not hesitate to ask competitors who refuse to comply to leave the event.*

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

JUNIOR HANDLING

For handlers aged 18 years old and under on the day of the show. Dogs will run at their appropriate height.

ABC

All large dogs that are not a Collie breed or any cross of Collie breed

TEAM AGILITY

Each team will consist of three or four dogs, with the three best scores to count. Competitors who wish to enter the team events should fill out the section Day 2 on the entry form (online or postal) for the show.

Each team must be made up of either all large dogs or a combination of medium and small dogs (can be all small or all medium). For Agility and Jumping classes, 1st to 4th places will be awarded for two categories: 1) Large teams and 2) Medium & Small teams.

All dogs will compete at their own height individually and as per the running order for the class (posted on the day).

Competitors must submit their chosen teams no later than 10am on Sunday morning. Teams will be created from any competitors that have not been submitted on chosen teams once all chosen teams have been received.

DECLARATON, UNDERTAKING AND AGREEMENT BY OWNER OR AGENT
